## 2021 FLORENCE NIGHTINGALE NURSE IMMERSION PROGRAM

The **2021 Florence Nightingale Nurse Immersion Program** is designed to provide an 8 week course for emerging MS nursing professionals. Selected nurses will meet weekly for 1 hour to learn about MS advancing from beginner to an intermediate level. **Meetings will be held via zoom in the evenings** to allow working professionals to attend and learn from experienced MS faculty. Advantages of this immersion will include small group learning, immediate answers to questions from faculty, real world case studies and networking with other nurses from the US in a virtual setting.

- Nurses selected must attend and complete all eight sessions
- At the end of the program, the attendees will be awarded \$500 to support the cost of the nursing certification examination in MS nursing (MSCN), to be taken in November 2021
