Leny reviewed the process for how the buddy program works. Marie Moore inquired about "who did we target?" Feedback was solicited from members re. their experiences.

Marie encourages members to partner w/ industry; she has received at least

three names of new nurses that would be great for the buddy program.

Jeffery requested 'a card' to give out to Pharma when they visit members' offices.

Marie: really emphasized the need to reach out to pharma and partner so "we can get the word out"

Buddy Program to contribute to the list of MSL/CLL. It was suggested to update the IOMSN database.

Bonnie reviewed statistics from last year.

Biogen has agreed to place the IOMSN slide at the end of their presentations/slide decks to help with IOMSN awareness.

Marguerite Herman clarified just what exactly the "Council of Sponsors" is. Also, she added that the approximate costs for "booths" may exceed \$1,000; often up to \$5,000 to secure a spot in exhibit halls at any conference.

Susan Agland: suggested that IOMSN should have representationa 'table' or 'booth' at all International Meetings. Their national conference is in September. Ideas for cross-pollination/Susan Agland said that posting on other social media is in line with what IOMSN communication committee.

June/Leny may provide a list of current MSL/CLL that we may be able to speak with and distribute with talking points for board members What would be the "pull" for Australian nurses or other international nurses to be members of IOMSN vs other "cross ocean" collaboration and increase networking. A membership survey will be sent – "Why We Stayed" – IOMSN staff

It was suggested that IOMSN become more visible at International Meetings i.e.
ECTRIMS. Joan requested clarification on the process involved in having representation Internationally/costs.

June would like to see us focus on APN, Neuroscience nurses, AANP.

How to "sell IOMSN"? - members discussed 'benefits to membership'.

Jeffery Hernandez feels access to IOMSN website/all materials should be associated w/ membership. Nonmembers have Full access and a few members felt this may not be helping w/ memberships.

Denies clarified: "If we kept all the information behind closed doors, more people might join to access the information."

Requiring membership for online access is recommended. "We may be missing the boat for some people who may not have the resources to network with our group" (Jeffery)

June suggested we may need to hire a PR firm. June feels we need to poll "active members" - Why do you stay?

	Funding changes through the government have affected a number of nurses.	
	Susan discussed ongoing efforts in Australia to promote MSCN as well as post covid strategies to re-engage	

members and create opportunities for growth which include the following:

- 1. Alternative Meeting location altered to minimize travel costs, and increased registration, sponsorship opportunities to attend the conference. Increased face-to-face attendance, and increased membership (currently 99, up from 82 in 2022).
- 2. Increase awareness of MSCN role and increased need for access, esp in rural and regional areas.

  Multiple media engagements and governance outreach to highlight outcomes of the MS Nurse report (msa ms-nurses-report-summary\_web.pdf (msaustralia.org.au) utilized.
- 3. Opportunities were taken to showcase the role of MS nurses and the benefits of having access to MS-certified nurses, especially in areas w/specialty care is not available.

Australia can have any drug at any point "fall off" formulary. Generics have taken over the market. Avonex nor Rebif available any longer. Wallette shared her experiences w/ International nurses and her time on MSNICB Board. She shared feedback from international nurses, their requests.

Susan shared that Pharma in Australia Pharma is no longer supporting nurses

	to go outside their country. Susan feels that other nurses abroad do not understand what they are missing.
